



Zane State Equivalency Guide: *Bachelor of Criminal Justice*

Transferring Into the Criminal Justice Major

The upper-division Criminal Justice major program is designed for students who have previously completed an associate's degree program in a technical area related to criminal justice, such as law enforcement, corrections technology, police administration, legal assisting, or human services. If you hold such a degree from Zane State College you are eligible to apply to the Criminal Justice major program and may earn a baccalaureate degree by completing a minimum of 80 additional hours of Ohio University work.

Requirements for All BCJ Majors

1. Earn at least 192 credit hours, including at least 48 of Ohio University work
2. Must complete at least 45 hours at the 300 level or above
3. Complete the General Education requirements (Tier I, II, III).
4. At least 50 percent of the coursework taken in the major (core and area requirements) must be completed at OU
5. Complete the BCJ core and no fewer than 9 courses from within the following BCJ Major Requirement areas:
