



Zane State Equivalency Guide: Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies

The BTAS degree is designed for the busy working adult who works in management or who desires to move into a management or administrative position in a field that involves technology. The BTAS maximizes the transfer of previously-earned credits. For many students, the BTAS will be a “Two-plus-Two” taking only two additional years of coursework beyond the two years already spent earning the associate degree. The program is specifically designed for students who have already completed an associate degree particularly a two-year associate degree in a technical field.

Admission Requirements

- Students may be admitted during any quarter
- 2.0 g.p.a. in 48 quarter hours or 32 semester hours

Credit Hour Summary

- Associate Degree: 96 with technical component of (36-45 hours)
- General Education Requirements: 24-36 (beyond Associate degree)
- TAS Major Requirements: 51-56
- Electives to meet minimum degree requirements: 4-22
- **Total: 174-210 hours**

The program requirements for BTAS are broken down into four areas: professional skills; cultural, political-and social issues; behavioral sciences; and leadership/organization.
