## Zane State Equivalency Guide: *Bachelor of Communication Studies*

A bachelor's degree in communication studies is perfect preparation for a career in corporate training, foreign service, law, politics, labor relations, human services, campaign management, event planning, account representation, sales, management, or survey research. All told, the major is designed to augment students' lives and careers through a clearer understanding of the effects of communication and messages in their professional and personal lives. Two communication tracks are offered in their entirety on the Zanesville Campus, some courses will be taught via the Ohio University Learning Network (OULN), while others are available online. This provides students with experience in a number of mediums in addition to the face to face interaction with our faculty.

### Requirements for Communication Studies Majors

Students are required to complete a total of 192 total hours specified by the University in order to graduate. As part of the 192 hours all students are required to complete the university general education curriculum, all majors in the School of Communication Studies must complete (1) seven core courses, (2) two theory courses in the student's concentration and one theory course in one of the other concentrations, (3) one course in research methods, (4) one concentration-specific internship or practicum, (5) one course in advanced presentations, (6) three elective courses in the School, (7) a minimum of 28-hours in a related area approved by a faculty advisor, (8) three consecutive quarters of another language or a Study Abroad experience or three courses emphasizing cultural topics, and (9) two courses in contemporary technology. Only one approved course in the major can be applied toward the University's Tier II requirements.
